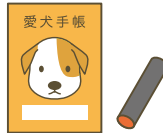
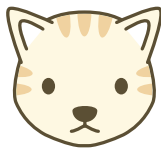




What to do when a dog or cat dies

- Pet dogs or cats that have died can be taken care of at Kofu/ Kyoto Clean Center.
*Please bring a driver's license or a document confirming your address.

Charged 【¥756 (tax incl.) for 1 pet】



*A registration cancellation procedure is required when a pet dog dies.
Please bring your dog license and dog identification to the Environmental Center.
(Telephone calls are accepted.)

Burning trash outdoors



The burning of wastes outdoors is forbidden by law, with some exceptions.

Things that are forbidden to burn regardless of the size or quantity

- Burning of household trash or waste
- Burning of wood waste or tatami mats, etc. that come from when dismantling a house
- Burning of paper wastes, etc. produced from commercial activities
- Burning of waste tires, etc. for the prevention of frost damage
- Burning of mulching and vinyl used for vinyl houses for farming

Exceptions

- Burning of rice straws, cut branches, etc. by farmers, foresters, etc.
- Burning involved with traditional customs such as "Dondo-yaki" or religious events
- Burning or starting a fire for casual daily activities (bonfire, campfire, burning of firewood to keep warm etc.)

***In either of the above cases, other trashes such as plastics must not be burned together.**

We ask for the cooperation of each individual in the city of Kofu to help stop the illegal burning of trash outdoors!
Be careful not to cause trouble to neighbors in the case of exceptions!

Please use the recycling station

***Please do not bring trash from restaurants or offices.**

Unlike the collection areas of recyclables in the city, recyclables can be brought to the recycling station on any day when a certain amount of household trash has accumulated. Trash can be brought within the hours shown below. Please follow instructions for disposal such as washing and sorting of trash.

Disposable recyclables

*Please make sure to sort trash, and place in transparent/ semitransparent bags.

- Glass Bottles (colorless/ colored bottles)
- Plastic bottles (colorless)
- Magazines ● Cardboard boxes
- Paper cartons (cut open)
- Ink cartridges
- Cans (aluminum can/ steel can/ spray can)
- Newspaper (includes newspaper inserts)
- Dispose of items colored in silver on the interior as mixed paper
