How to throw out "plastic containers and packages"



Plastic containers and packages are also important resources!



Please dispose of in transparent/ semitransparent plastic bags.

Transparent/ semitransparent disposable shopping bags are also acceptable.

*Plastic containers/ packages cannot be disposed of in bags for burnable trash (yellow) or non-burnable trash (sky blue).
*If possible, please dispose of in large bags since they can be easily blown away by winds.



1 Place trash at the same collection spot for "burnable trash" no later than 8:30 a.m. on every Saturday

2 Properly sort trash **3** Tie the ends of the bags


*Small bags should not be placed altogether in one large bag

What are plastic containers and packages?

- Containers or packages that become unnecessary after taking out or eating the containing product
- Wrappings of containers or packages



Burnable trash
Plastic containers and packages
Non-burnable trash
Over-size trash that don't fit in bags
Flammable/ Ignitable trash
Recyclable materials (bicycles, valves)
Paper/ paper cartons/ clothing material
Metal/ cans/ plastic bottles/ white food trays

Transparent/ Semitransparent


Disposable items

● **Cups**
*Empty the cup, quickly rinse and drain if dirty!



Instant noodle cups, plastic cup containers for puddings and yoghurt, etc.

● **Bags** *Empty the bags!



Plastic packaging containing bread, rice, sweets, frozen food products, and disposable shopping bags, etc.

● **Bottles** *Rinse and drain the bottles!



Plastic bottle containers for shampoo, conditioner, detergent, fermented milk beverages such as Yakult, or Calpico, etc.

● **Packages/ colored plastic trays**



Plastic packages/ colored trays for eggs, tofu, sashimi (raw fish), deli, etc.

● **Lids/ labels/ wrapping films**



Container lids, labels on plastic bottles, and wrapping films, etc.

● **Cushion materials**



Styrofoam packing materials, bubble wraps, etc.

Be careful!!

Dispose of "plastic bottles" and "white food trays" as **recyclable/ valuables** the same as always

Dispose of "plastic bottle caps" in the **collecting box**

*These are also collected as plastic containers and packages. →Page 7

*You can leave labels or stickers that cannot be taken off easily.

Non-disposable items

Be careful!!

● Toys
● Plastic washbasin
● Plastic forks/ spoons
● Stationeries

Dispose as **burnable trash**.

● Tubes
● Containers for cooking oil, margarine, etc.
● Retort pouches

Items that cannot be cleaned easily can be disposed of as **burnable trash**.

*Clean items are disposed of as plastic containers and packages.

● Plastic wardrobe boxes
Plastic containers for water or gas

Dangerous items

● Razor
Wrap in cloth/ newspaper and place in designated trash bags

● Disposable lighters
Use up the lighter fluid and place in the corner of the trash collection area.

Dispose as **non-burnable trash**

Hospital wastes

● Injection needle
● Syringe
