



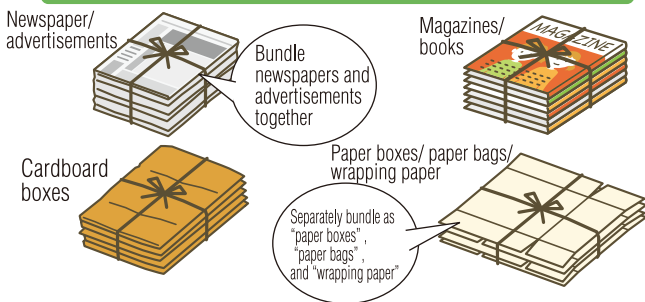
How to throw out "recyclables and valuables"

Recyclables (recyclable or valuable materials/ mixed paper) do not need to be disposed of in designated trash bags

- 1 Place at the trash collection area no later than 8:30 a.m. on the day of collection (time differs for collection of valuables)**
- 2 Place separately clothing materials, cans, bottles, and plastic bottles in transparent/ semitransparent bags**
 - Disposable items for recyclable materials and valuables are the same. Recyclable materials are collected by the city, and valuables are mainly collected by the local district association.
 - Valuables are voluntarily collected according to groups, and so some residential districts may not be collecting. Please confirm with your local district association or apartment regarding the collection area and time.
- 3 Place recyclable materials in the designated collection area of that day (the same as non-burnable trash)**

*Please do not take home papers, bottles, and metals that have been thrown out at trash collection areas

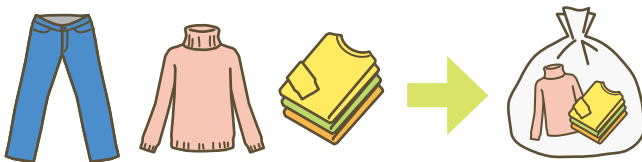


Paper cartons



***If there are any materials other than paper attached such as strings or vinyl, please dispose of as mixed paper.**
***Please place in transparent/ semitransparent bags on raining days to prevent from getting wet.**

Clothing material



***Please place in transparent/ semitransparent bags to keep clean.**

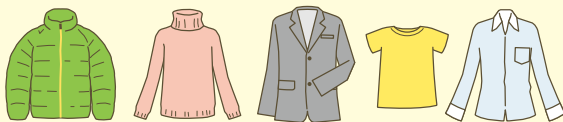


How to throw out clothing materials

Clothing materials are mainly exported overseas, then reused as second hand clothing or industrial waste cloth. For this reason, we ask that you place them in transparent/ semitransparent bags to keep them clean and prevent them from getting wet.

Disposable items

Mostly all clothing materials used in standard households can be disposed of. Please make sure to wash them before disposal.



- Jacket, t-shirt, sweater, suits, blouse, etc.
- Trousers, skirt ● underwear ● curtains
- Blankets, towels, bed sheets ● socks (only in pairs)

*Children's clothes, leather clothing, kimono, sweat shirt, scarves, and futon covers are also disposable.

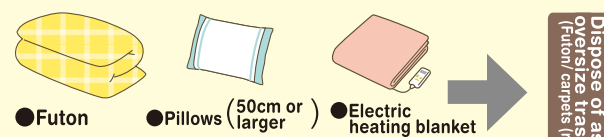
Please also give to people, sell at flea markets or recycle stores.

Non-disposable items



Dispose of as burnable trash

*Shoes, toilet seat covers, vinyl raincoat, hats, gloves, bags, and neckties are also non-disposable.



Dispose of as oversize trash (Futon/ carpets/ rugs)

*Floor cushions, rugs, mattresses for kotatsu, carpets, and door or bath mats are also non-disposable.

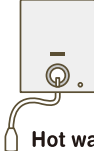
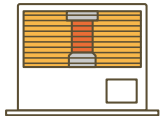
*Separate aluminum cans and steel cans, and dispose of them in transparent/ semitransparent bags, respectively.



Please attach a slip stating "waste (廃棄)" on the basket, etc.



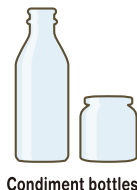
*Dispose of carbon items as non-burnable large size trash.



Make sure to take out batteries and drain fuel

*Please make sure to take out batteries and drain fuel.

Bottles



Please dispose of metal caps together with cans.



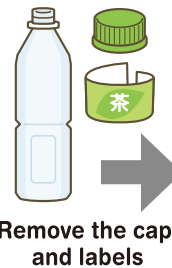
*Please dispose of in transparent/ semitransparent bags.

Dispose of glass kitchenware, plate glass, heat-resisting glass, crystal glass as **non-burnable trash**

Removed caps will be collected from the collection location of valuables and waste cooking oil as plastic containers and packages.
*Please dispose of labels as plastic containers and packaging.

Crush



*Please dispose of in transparent/ semitransparent bags.

Please dispose of colored bottles and bottles with plastic handles as **burnable trash**.

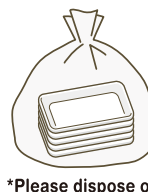
White food trays

*Please dispose of in transparent/ semitransparent bags.

Be careful!!
Please dispose of colored, patterned, or packaging trays, and Styrofoam as **plastic containers and packages**.

Reusable harmful materials

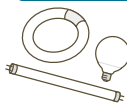
Batteries (manganese/ alkaline batteries)



Please place in transparent bags and keep separately from other trashes in the corner of the collection area.
*External bags of designated trash bags can also be used.

Other batteries Please use collection boxes placed at electronic stores, etc. for other batteries such as button batteries, lithium batteries, and rechargeable batteries (secondary batteries).

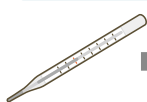
Fluorescent light/ fluorescent tube/ bulb type fluorescent light



Place in boxes it came in at the time of purchase

*Dispose of LED and incandescent lamps as **non-burnable trash**

Clinical thermometer/ blood pressure manometer/ thermometer (using mercury)



Please place in transparent vinyl/ plastic bags and keep in the corner of collection areas.

*Dispose of those not using mercury as **non-burnable trash**
